What personal characteristics about Adams pick for militia commander made him stand out as a confident pick for leader of the colonial matters? 3. What prevented Washington from speaking out as much as a leader typically would during this critical time in American creation? 4. Who was Benedict Arnold? Why is his name synonymous with the term traitor? 5. Explain the benefit of the colonial victory from Fort Ticonderoga. 6. Who was the "14th colony" sought after in order to aid the American colonists? Who was asked to lead the military ranks during the attack?
- 7. Describe the trek that Benedict Arnold and his regiment endured while attempting to break into British Canada. When did things begin to turn for them?
- 8. What was the plan in order to besiege the city of Quebec? Was it a success?
- 9. When Ben Franklin returned to the colonies in the summer of 1775 what major task did he take on concerning personal matters with him and his son?

13. What important factor was omitted from the wording of the Declaration of Independence before it would be adopted by the colonists in July 1776?
14. Why was July 4 <sup>th</sup> 1776 a somber day for Benjamin Franklin?
15. Why was it important for General Washington to read out loud the wording of the Declaration of Independence to his troops on July 9 <sup>th</sup> 1776?
16. How did the British react to the release of the Declaration of Independence?
17. Why was New York an important feat to gain during the Revolutionary War?
18. What did David Bushnell invent to aid the colonial troops during the war? Did the invention help during the war?
