## Progressive Reformers Job Fair

You have been assigned to assume the character of an early twentieth century progressive. Your task is to research your reformer and create a **ONE PAGE RESUME** (using the template provided) for “yourself” that includes a space for a picture and information pertaining to six categories (*objective, summary, professional experience, major accomplishments, references and memorable quote*) on the form. In addition to the resume worksheet you will need to create a **NAMEPLATE** that identifies you (and any information you wish to share).

During the next few class periods we will work on your resume and conduct on-site interviews for best reformer. On interview day you will display your nameplate and share your resume with interested Progressives. Extra credit points will be awarded for **PROPS** brought in which effectively portray your character.

Use your notes from the textbook and online credible resources to research your character. Focus mainly on what your reformer did during the time period 1900-1920. This is not a complete biography of his/her life, therefore nothing after 1920 will need to be included.
